


If my parting has left a void then fill it with remembered joys. A friendship shared, a laugh, a kiss; Oh yes, these things, I too will miss.

BART HRIBAR

November 18, 1938 - June 14, 2024

It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Bart Hribar on Friday, June 14, 2024, at the Coaldale Long Term Care Facility following a courageous battle with Parkinson's disease.

Bart was born on November 18, 1938, in Zlato Polje, Slovenia, to Jernej and Antonija Hribar. After being displaced from their farm in World War II, Bart and his family lived in a camp in Austria before immigrating to Canada in 1949 to work on a beet farm. After graduating high school, Bart started his career in banking.

Bart had a distinguished career at the Bank of Nova Scotia, where he worked for 35 years across four different provinces where his jovial nature endeared him to his customers. In 1978, he moved to Lethbridge, where he remained until his passing.
